## **SERVING EVERYONE**

- The YMCA has been serving the Harbordale community since 1993 providing quality programs that meet the needs of a broad spectrum of the community including children, teens, adults, elderly and disabled individuals regardless of their socio-economic status. Where need is demonstrated and funding is available, our goal is to ensure that no one will be turned away for inability to pay.
- In 2008, the YMCA gave more than \$811,000 in scholarships and program subsidies including \$76,464 to Harbordale participants.

## **YOUTH PROGRAMS – A SERVICE TO OUR FUTURE**

- The Y-Achievers Program provided academic and literacy programs for 117 elementary age children who are at risk of failing in school.
- The Prodigy Program used the arts to reach more than 100 at-risk youth at Harbordale by encouraging imagination and creativity to form a unique and strong sense of identity.
- The Fit Active Black (FAB) Families Program taught 152 youth the value of healthy eating and exercising.

## **ADULT PROGRAMS – A SERVICE TO OUR RESIDENTS**

- The Computer Lab is free and open to the public throughout the year. In 2008 the lab was used over 55 times.

## **CHILD CARE – A SERVICE TO OUR FAMILIES**

- Camp programs provided fun, structured activities to promote social development for more than 150 children during summer, spring break, Thanksgiving, and the winter holiday.
- 16 families including 26 kids were given free child care and Adult Financial Education classes through a grant from the United Way of Tampa Bay.

## **HEALTH AND WELLNESS PROGRAMS – A SERVICE TO OUR QUALITY OF LIFE**

- Active Older Adults™ and SilverSneakers® programs brought 679\* senior adults together to participate in health and wellness activities and form supportive friendships to enhance their quality of life.
- Fitness Equipment including treadmills and exercise bikes, are available free for the community.

## **SPECIAL EVENTS – A SERVICE TO OUR NEIGHBORHOOD**

- The Harbordale facility was built as a multi-purpose space where the mid-town community would have a safe, inviting atmosphere for programs designed around their needs. Community events such as the Neighborhood Flea Market and Pot Luck Dinners helped bring the families of Mid-town together.
- At the Sixth Annual Mayor's Pancake Breakfast, sponsored by International House of Pancakes, 208 community members ate an endless supply of pancakes made by St. Petersburg's Mayor Rick Baker.
- Harbordale is also available for community meetings such as the Harbordale Neighborhood Association, Untied Way, and Boy Scout Troops.
